2016 SUMMER CAMP IN CHINA

(3 weeks)

Camp # 1 – July 4 - 24, 2016; Camp # 2 – July 18 - August 7, 2016



For grade 9 to grade 12 students and teachers only. Application deadline March 31, 2016. Package price \$2,499/person Canadian includes round trip flight ticket, accommodation, meals, tips for tour guide and driver and taxes. Price does not include transportation to and/from the airport, travel insurance and Chinese visa fee.

Spend an unforgettable three weeks in China this summer and **earn one credit course in Travel and Tourism** (Course Code CGG30) from the Durham Catholic District School Board. For two weeks you will be with a sister school in the beautiful city of Hangzhou to learn about Chinese culture and make friends with local students. One week you will travel to Beijing, Qufu and Shanghai. This program is organized by Durham Catholic District School Board in partnership with Tenkey Education Group, and is sponsored by Yuhang District Government and Yuhang District Education Bureau of City of Hangzhou. Yuhang is a friendship city of the City of Pickering. Tenkey Education Group is a Durham Region based company that promotes educational and cultural exchange between Canada and China.

Program Overview:

- Day 1 Departure from Toronto to Beijing.
- Day 2 Arrival in Beijing.
- Day 3 and Day 4 Beijing Tour.
- Day 5 Qufu Confucius Temple Tour.
- Day 6 and Day 7 Shanghai Tour.
- Day 8 – Day 20 Hangzhou:

Morning: school campus activities with local Chinese students to learn about Chinese language, calligraphy, Chinese musical instruments, Chinese painting, Chinese Kung Fu etc.

Afternoon: Hangzhou city excursions to learn about the Chinese Culture in depth. This will include museums, sightseeing, shows and ancient town visits.

- Day 21 - Departure from Beijing/Shanghai and return to Toronto

Accommodation:

Day 1 to day 7 participants will be staying at a Holiday Inn hotel or equivalent rating. Day 8 to day 20 participants will be staying at the school dormitory which has 24-hour air conditioning and showers.

One Credit for Travel and Tourism:

One credit for Travel and Tourism (Course Code CGG30) will be earned once the student meets the requirement from Durham Catholic District School Board upon completion of the Summer Camp.
